OREGON LEGACY 2012 CONCLUDES JANUARY 29th



Driftwood Public Library's 18th Annual Oregon Legacy literary series wraps up on Sunday, January 29th at 3:00 p.m. with a visit from former Governor Barbara Roberts.

Governor Roberts served as Oregon's first female Governor from 1990-94. During her term as Governor, Roberts worked with the Clinton administration to secure federal waivers and funding for the Oregon Health Plan. She also helped to increase the number of children in the Head Start Program, secured financing for additional units of affordable housing, and developed programs to help move Oregonians from welfare to the workplace. Her husband, Frank Roberts, died in 1993 from prostate cancer while she was still governor. After his death, Governor Roberts

wrote the book *Death Without Denial, Grief Without Apology: A Guide for Facing Death and Loss*. Her memoir, *Up the Capitol Steps*, came out in 2011.
