

Library Card Design Contest  
RULES

1. Contestants must currently reside in, or own property in, Driftwood Public Library's service area of North Lincoln County. This is defined as the area within Lincoln County bordered by (and including) Depoe Bay to the South and the Tillamook County line to the North.
2. Contestants must submit their design on an official entry form which can be obtained either from the Circulation Desk at Driftwood or downloaded from Driftwood's website at [www.driftwoodlib.org](http://www.driftwoodlib.org).
3. Computer-created artwork may be submitted. The file should be in .jpg or .pdf format at a resolution of 300 dpi. Entry forms in both .jpg and .pdf formats are available on the website above. Files should be attached to an e-mail and sent to [kenh@lincolncity.org](mailto:kenh@lincolncity.org). The e-mail's subject line *must* read "Card Contest Entry".
4. The contest is for artwork only. Artwork should be appropriate for a public library in Lincoln City, Oregon. The library will add text to the artwork to suit its needs. Artwork within the solid red lines may be cropped to suit the card's final design (in other words, the library may decide to use only a *portion* of the winning entry); artwork outside of the solid red lines will not be considered part of the submission. Artwork does *not* have to fill the entire design space within the solid red lines. Artwork may be shrunk to approximately 1/3<sup>rd</sup> original size or smaller on final library cards.
5. Contestants must include the following information on their entries: Name, Physical Residential Address (P.O. Boxes don't count), Phone Number and e-Mail address (if applicable).
6. Contestants must include their age with their entries (one of two categories: "12-and-Under" or "Over 12").
7. Entries are due *at the library*, whether by mail, e-mail or hand-delivered, no later than 8:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2012.
8. One winner and two runners-up will be chosen in each of the two age categories listed above. Winners will be notified by the library either by e-Mail or by phone on or near March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012. Winners will be asked to sign a release form allowing the library to use their artwork for the library cards and for publicity purposes. If a winner fails to sign a release form, the 1<sup>st</sup> runner up in that age category will be declared the winner.
