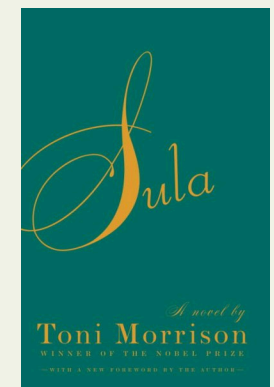
Love the idea of a book club, but not interested in peopling? Or maybe you want to join a book club but have no time to attend. We get you.
